

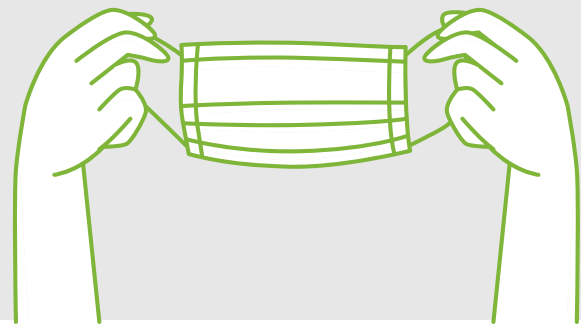


Ensuring safety during the pandemic

Correct PPE

We ensure a good supply of PPE equipment at all our homes.



Strict Cleaning & Infection Control

A strict cleaning regime is in place along with an infection control procedure.

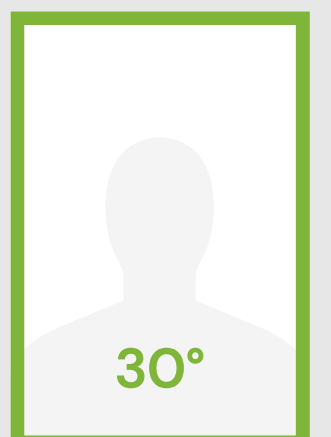
Hand Sanitisation Systems

Automatic hand sanitisation systems have been installed across all our homes.



Thermal Imaging

We have thermal imaging screens at the entrance of each of our homes to monitor staff temperatures and ensure nobody comes into the homes with a fever.



Controlled Visits

Visits are restricted by each home to keep residents safe. Organised video calls are run by each home with some accepting pre-booked window visits. **Check with your specific home**



Safe Admissions

We are still accepting new residents into our homes on the basis that they have a negative Covid test result and that they are willing to isolate for 7 days as a precaution.

Covid Testing

We are performing regular Covid tests in all our care homes to ensure there are no active cases in our homes.

This includes:

- weekly tests for all staff
- monthly tests for our residents
- required negative test results for new admissions or returning residents
